CHAPTER 1

The Roots of a King

From the very beginning, heaven proclaimed a truth that will
never change:

**“Jesus Christ is King of kings and Lord of lords.”(Revelation
19:16)**

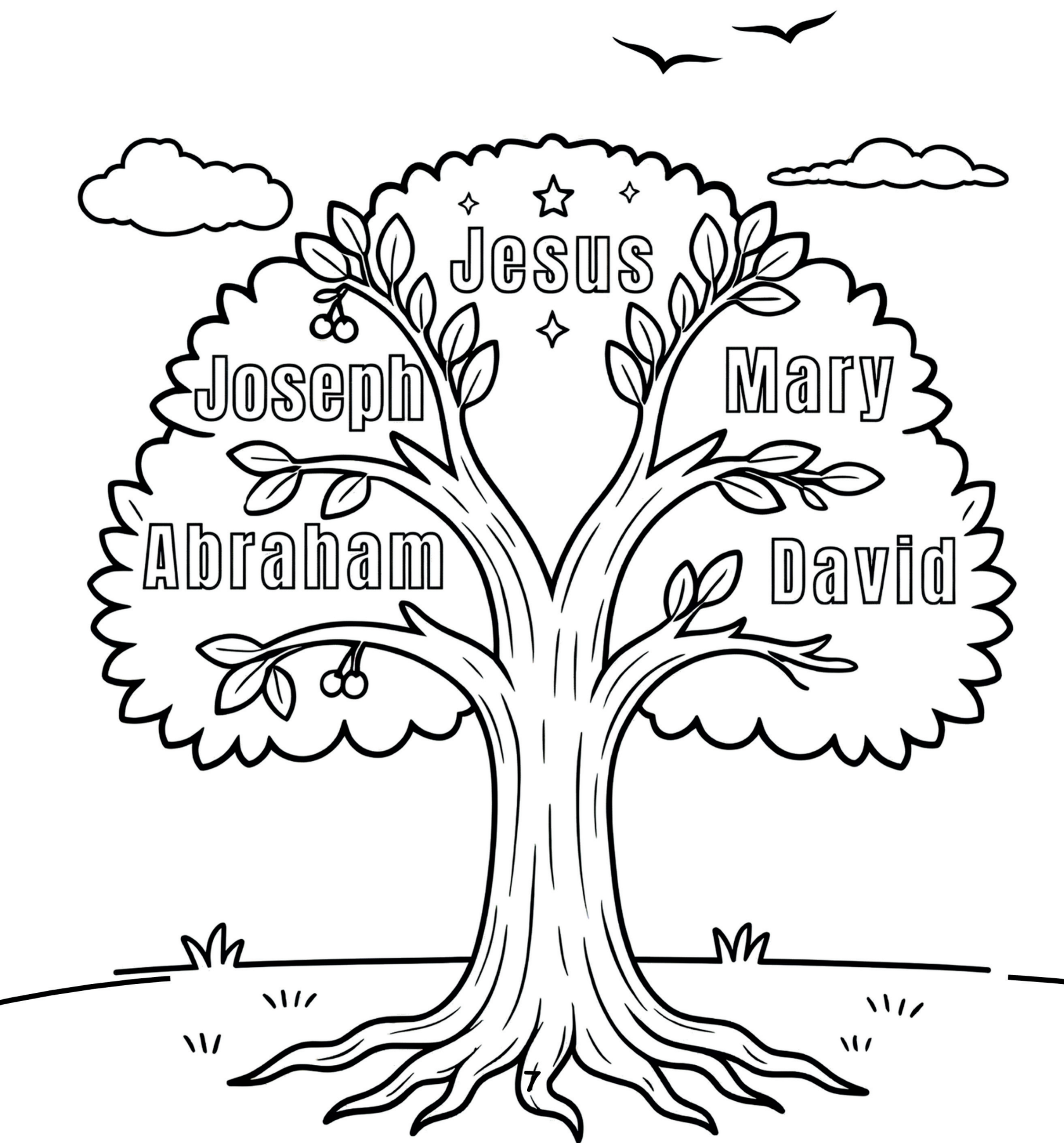
He is the King above every king, the Lord above every ruler, and His kingdom has no end. But unlike earthly kings who suddenly appear in power, God chose a different way to reveal His Son.

This great King was born into a family. He entered our world through a humble stable, into the arms of a young mother, and into a family line carefully prepared across centuries. Jesus’ story as King did not begin in Bethlehem—it began in the heart of God and was written through generations long before His birth.

From Adam to Abraham

Let’s go all the way back to the very beginning—to Adam, the very first man. God formed Adam from the dust of the earth and gave him life with His own breath.

From Adam came Seth, and after many, many years, a man named Noah was born—the one who built the big boat called the Ark.



After the great flood, Noah's son Shem had children, and so did their children. Many, many generations later, a man named Abraham was born. God made Abraham a beautiful promise:

"Through your family, all the nations of the earth will be blessed." (Genesis 22:18)

That blessing was pointing to Jesus.

From Abraham to David.

Abraham had a son named Isaac, and Isaac had a son named Jacob. One of Jacob's sons was named Judah, and from Judah's family came a shepherd boy named David.

David loved God with all his heart, and one day, he became a mighty king. God told David that someone from his family would be King forever—not just in one country, but over all creation.

That promise also pointed to Jesus.

From King David to Joseph and Mary

After King David, there were many kings and many more generations. Some followed God. Others didn't. But God never broke His promise. He kept weaving His plan through the families of time.



Much later, in a little town called Nazareth, there lived a good man named Joseph. He was a carpenter, and he came from King David's family. Joseph was engaged to a young woman named Mary. Mary loved God deeply. And one day, an angel would appear to her with the most amazing news.

The Son of Man and the Son of God

Joseph wasn't Jesus' father. God was. Jesus came from heaven. That's why Jesus is called the Son of God—because He came from the heart of the Father above.

But He's also called the Son of Man—because He was born just like you and me, through a mother, into a family, with cousins, ancestors, and generations before Him.

The Bible says:

"Jesus... was the son (as was supposed) of Joseph... the son of David... the son of Abraham... the son of Noah... the son of Adam, the son of God."

(Luke 3:23-38)

Jesus came to earth to live with us, laugh with us, cry with us, and save us.

He is the King from David's line, the blessing from Abraham's promise, and the Savior of the world from the heart of God.

He is both Son of Man and Son of God.

And His story is just beginning.
